BIBLE STORY: David and Jonathan
1 Samuel 18-20

BOTTOM LINE: Honor Others by
Putting Them First

ARROWS AND QUIVER ACTIVITY

WHAT TO DO:

Hand each kid 2 craft sticks, 2 black triangles, 2 black rectangles, "A friend loves at all times" label, and 1/2 sheet of brown construction paper. Set out small brown pipe cleaners, scissors, glue stick, and tape.

SAY:

In our story today, Jonathan was a good friend to David and he wanted to protect him from his father. Do you remember what Jonathan said the arrow would tell David? (If the arrow was shot close to him, David was safe; if the arrow was shot far away, David was to run.) Let's have some fun and make our own arrows and quiver. Here's what to do:

1. Glue a black triangle at the top of each craft stick for the point of the arrows.
2. Glue black rectangles to the bottom of each craft stick for the "fletching" (bottom of the arrow).
3. To make the quiver (pouch), fold the short ends of a 1/2 sheet of brown construction paper to meet in the middle, overlapping to make it wide at the top and narrow at the bottom and tape together.
4. Fold the bottom up about an inch and tape together, to make a pouch.
5. Create a loop with the small brown pipe cleaner and tape to the back of the quiver.
6. Cut out one "A friend loves at all times" label.
7. Glue your label to the front of your quiver.
8. Put your arrows inside the quiver.

JONATHAN'S PRESENT TO DAVID ACTIVITY

WHAT TO DO:

K/1st - Grab one sheet of the Jonathan's present to David activity and work as a team to figure out the puzzle.

2/3rd - hand each kid a Jonathan's Present to David activity. Help them figure out the puzzle.



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
