BOTTOM LINE: Honor Others by
Keeping Your Promises

KEEPING PROMISES FRIENDSHIP BRACELET ACTIVITY

WHAT TO DO:

Hand each kid a pipe cleaner. Set out colored straws and scissors

SAY:

Keeping our promises is very important so we're going to make a "Keeping Promises Friendship bracelet to remind us to always keep our promises. Here's what to do:

1. Hand each kid a pipe cleaner and a different colored straw.
2. Cut your straw into 10 pieces to make beads.
3. Put the straw pieces in the middle of the group.
4. Now, wrap your pipe cleaner around your wrist to measure a bracelet.
5. Cut off the excess pipe cleaner.
6. Untwist your bracelet and take it off
7. Now, I'm going to instruct you to pick up a certain color bead and then I'll ask a question.
7. Everyone pick up a yellow bead and lace it on your pipe cleaner. Tell us this: What's your name?
8. Grab a green bead. Lace it and answer this: What's your favorite book?
9. Grab a blue bead. Lace it. What's your favorite movie?
10. Grab a pink bead. Lace it. Tell us the name or names of your friends.
11. Grab an orange bead. Lace it. Tell us who's in your family? (mom, dad, sister, uncles, grandparents, etc)
12. Last, take either a second of your favorite color or any color not yet used. Lace it. Think about all your friends and family. Who can you keep a promise to this week?

WHAT TO DO:

Hand out David and Mephibosheth Coloring pages and set out crayons.
