WHAT IS WORSHIP?

The Point: Worship is responding to who God is and what He's done in your life.

Verse: John 4:24 NLT

"For God is Spirit, so those who worship him must worship in spirit and in truth."

Ask:

1. Would you rather have to sing everything you say or only be able to speak in a very soft whisper? Why would you choose that?
2. What did you think of the video today? What did you like about it? What's one thing you learned?
3. Why do you think we come to church and sing songs? What is the purpose of singing songs at church?
4. What do you think about "worship time" at church? Do you like it? Do you not really like it? Why do you think that?
5. How do you usually worship: with hands up, dancing, singing, standing still, hands in your pocket? Or, do you not really pay attention during worship time? Why have you always done it that way?
6. Read John 4:24 out loud together.

7. What do you think this verse means and is talking about? How can you apply it to your life?
8. What excites you most about who God is and/or what God has done? What aspect or characteristic of God would you say is easiest to worship? Why is that?
9. What will be different about how you worship God now? Why?
