



## LUNCHROOM Week 2

**Bible Story:** Feed My Sheep

**Bottom Line:** Friends Forgive One Another

### PRE LARGE GROUP ACTIVITY

**Tie-dyed Baby Wipes:** Set out baby wipes and rubber bands. Set out markers.

**SAY:**

We are going to make a fun craft that looks like tie-dye! Take a baby wipe and hold it in the center. Twist it together and put rubber bands around the top, middle and bottom. In each of these 3 sections, use a marker to color it. Try to get in all of the little creases! When you are done, take off the rubber bands and unroll the wipe. Check out the cool design!

**CONVERSATION:**

1. What is a way that you can be creative (art projects, jewelry making, Lego building)?
2. If you could create an art project and could use ANY supplies, what would you use? Think outside the box!!

**SAY (AFTER ACTIVITY)**

Today we are going to learn about an important lesson that Jesus taught Peter. Let's listen to our friends at KR News!!

### MID LARGE GROUP ACTIVITY

**The Bible and Sheep Activity:** Read the Bible verse and then ask the questions.

**SAY:**

**Bible Verse:** Jesus saw the huge crowd as he stepped from the boat, and he had compassion on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things. Matthew 9:36

**Question:** How do you think the people were like sheep without a shepherd? (The people didn't know who to follow so Jesus taught them so they'd know His voice and follow Him.)

**Bible Verse:** If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them gets lost, what will he do? Won't he leave the ninety-nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it? Luke 15:4

**Question:** What does this story of the lost sheep have to do with us? (When we are lost, Jesus will not stop until he finds and rescues us.) What does it mean to be lost? (We don't know Jesus; we are hurting; we are ignoring Jesus.)

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**Bible Verse:** My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. John 10:27

**Questions:** Who is the shepherd and who are the sheep? (Jesus is the shepherd and we the listeners are the sheep) How do we get to know Jesus' voice? (read the Bible)

### POST LARGE GROUP ACTIVITY

**Paper Sheep Activity:** Hand each kid a strip of white paper, 4 cotton balls, and 2 googly eyes. Set out glue sticks, markers, labels, and black paper.

**SAY:**

Let's make a sheep to remember that we are God's sheep and that He loves us so much!

1. First, glue to ends of the white paper strip together, to make a loop. This is the sheep's body.
2. Next, put the label on the inside of the loop.
3. Color a face on the sheep.
4. Glue the 2 googly eyes to the sheep's face.
5. Glue 3 of the cotton balls to the back of the loop and spread them out to make your sheep wooly.
6. Glue the last cotton ball to the bottom of the loop, separating it into 2 pieces to make the feet.
7. Finally, glue 2 pieces of small black paper to make the ears.

**ASK:**

1. Why did Peter have to ask Jesus for forgiveness?
2. Why did Jesus call us sheep?

**PRAYER:**

Dear Lord, thank you for teaching us about the importance of forgiving our friends, even when they hurt us. Help us to tell others about your amazing love! We want to be more like You! Thank you for who you are, God. In Jesus name, Amen!
