# PRESENT SUGGESTIONS

We are collecting presents for children ages 2-21. Below is a list of ideas, as well as a list of items that are not allowed inside the GBB facilities:

## **SPORTS**

Balls, baseball & mitt, merchandise

## **ART**

Arts & crafts, markers, crayons, watercolor sets, stickers, play dough, coloring books, backpacks, school supplies, notebooks, calculators

## **COSMETICS**

Makeup, nail polish, lotions, face masks, hair clips, ribbons

## **ACCESSORIES**

Hats, beanies, watches, sunglasses, bags, water bottles

## **TOYS**

Stuffed animals, dolls, toy trucks, hot wheels, slinky, etch a sketch, yo-yo, magna tiles, puzzles, chalkboard and chalk, frisbee, jump rope, legos, board games

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

Small musical instruments (harmonica or recorder), blanket, gift card, electronics (headphones), fidget toys.

## **DO NOT INCLUDE**

Playing cards, dice, candy, toothpaste, food items, gum, smart watches, used or damaged items. Scary or war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures. Breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers, aerosol cans.
