

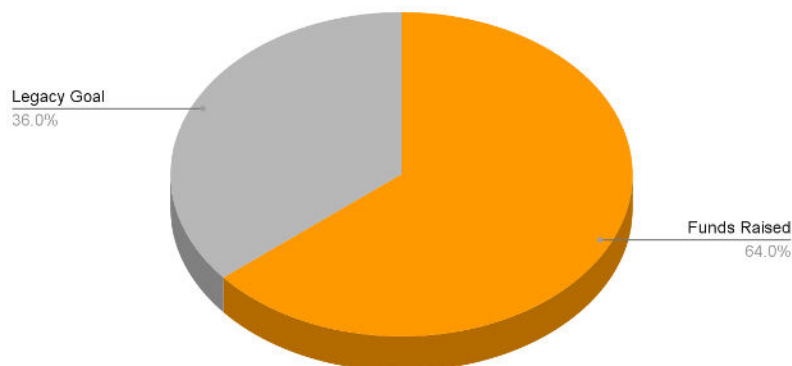

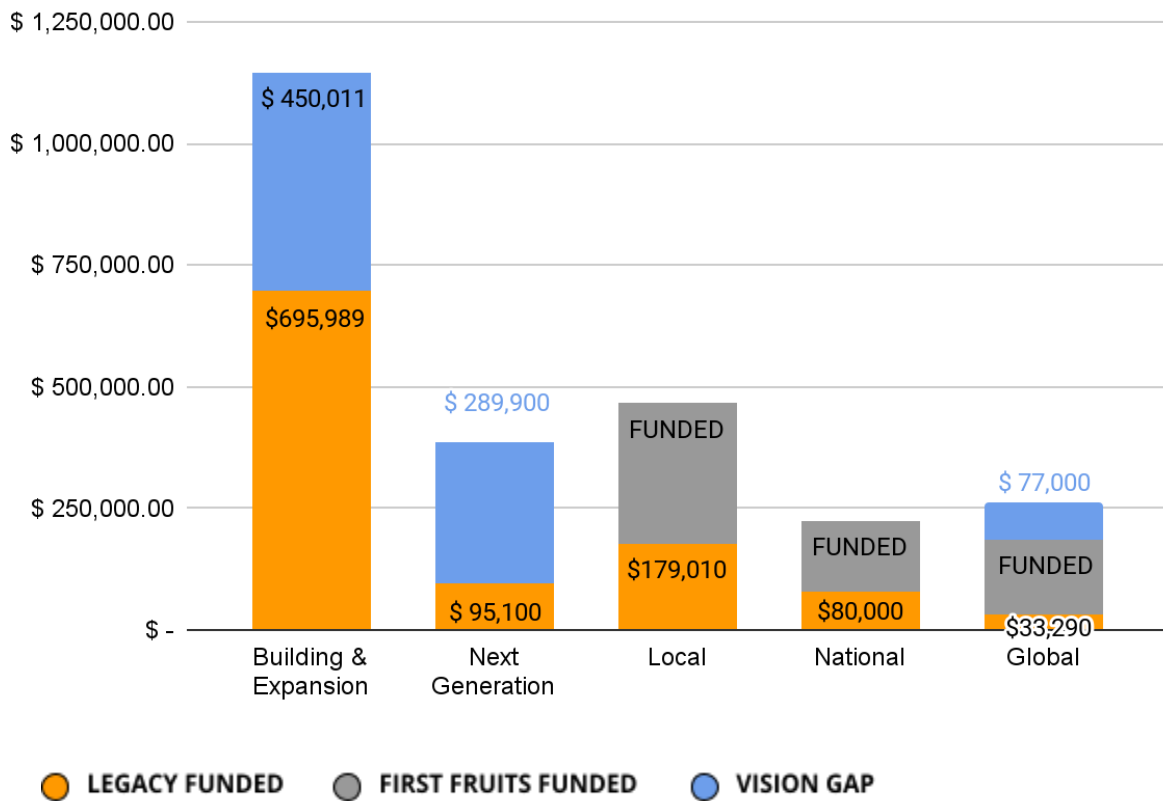
Summary Page - January 2023

Legacy Team Giving Progress Report 2022:

- We finished 2022 approximately 64% completed towards our Legacy Team funding goal of \$1.7million. The Team has raised \$1,092,449.25 from January 2022 to present.
- A combined \$105k was given from legacy families that wanted to directly fund our Special Need Rooms, Night to Shine and annual support of our God Behind Bars Ministry!
- We are praying that this team continues to accelerate the overall pace that this church is able to operate.



2022 Combined Vision Gap:



- This graph represents an emphatic push towards our Building and Expansion Lane for the calendar years of 2022/23. Our leadership team believes that creating new ministries to serve our communities, and caring for existing ones will set a new foundation for growth over the years to come.
- \$1,083,390 of Legacy funds have been distributed to various projects across the 5 Lanes of Impact. \$695,989 have been noted toward the Littleton Courtyard Project and finishing our Special Needs Rooms. \$95,100 have been distributed towards Youth Retreat Scholarships and Night to Shine. \$179,010 went towards funding the various projects during Love Our City week in July. \$80,000 have been given towards supporting our God Behind Bars campuses. \$33,290 has been given towards fully funding another well in Mabriyol, Haiti.
- Additional projects in our Local, National and Global Outreach organizations were supported by our First Fruits offering.
