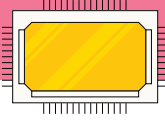


Easter is celebrating that Jesus is alive.

KNOW that Jesus' entry into Jerusalem fulfilled God's promise!

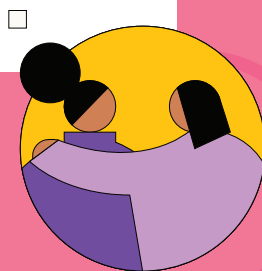

LOOK for Jesus in your day!



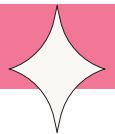
