What does it really mean to pray? Is it about saying the "right" words, closing your eyes, or hoping God hears you? In our new series, "Speak Up," students will discover that prayer is more than a habit or routine; it's an invitation to actually meet with God. To help us learn how, we're looking at a pattern of prayer that comes from the Tabernacle, the place where God's people went to be with Him. Just like the Israelites had a starting point when they entered the Tabernacle, we have a starting point in prayer, too.

The Bible says in Psalm 100:4, "Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise." That means we begin by thanking God for who He is and praising Him for what He's done. When we start with gratitude and worship, it sets the tone for the rest of our conversation with Him. In this series, students will see that prayer isn't complicated or intimidating; it's a journey of drawing close to God, step by step, and learning to hear His voice.
