WEEK 1

Ruth 1-2

Who went to Bethlehem with Naomi? (Ruth)

Who is in your family?

WEEK 2

Daniel needs to help the king, so he asks his friends Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego to pray to God.

Daniel 2

Who had a dream that worried him? (The king)

Who showed Daniel what the king's dream meant?

(God)

WEEK 3

God gives meat and bread to the Israelites while they are traveling through a desert.

Exodus 16

Who loved the Israelites and wanted

to take care of them? (God)

What food did God give the Israelites?

(Meat and bread)

WEEK 4

A woman and her husband help Elisha by building a room for him to stay in when he is in town.

2 Kings 4:8-17

Who traveled all over to tell people about God?

(Elisha)

What did the woman and her husband do for Elisha?

(Build a room)

WEEK 5

David dances with "all his might" to praise God and thank God for who He is and what He has done.

2 Samuel 6:12-15; Psalm 144:9-10

What is "praising God"?

(Thanking God for who He is and what He has done)

Who danced with "all his might"? (David)
