



## A Miracle Mindset | Shawn Johnson | 1.17-18

Welcome to week 2 of our vision series, **Miracle Mindset**. This series is going to build on that decision, because what we focus on shapes what we expect, and what we expect shapes how we pray. This week we are breaking down a simple foundation. This week we heard from our Global Senior Pastor Shawn Johnson.

A miracle is when God does what we cannot. A mindset is the focus we choose to set. When we pair the two, we are not pretending life is easy, we are deciding to put our hope in the God who still moves. Scripture is full of moments where people pray and God responds. Many of us get to a point where we believe we have tried everything, but that is not the end, it might be the beginning. We have to have the mindset that God is a miracle working God!

- What would change in your life if you genuinely believed God could do what you cannot?**

#### GROW

##### **Read Hebrews 4:16 & Colossians 3:2**

Hebrews 4:16 invites us to approach God's throne of grace with confidence, while Colossians 3:2 urges us to set our minds on things above. These verses pair divine presence with human intentionality, God is willing, but we must be mindful. The message is clear: miraculous transformation begins when we fully trust God's character and fix our thoughts on His promises, not our problems.

- What does it look like to approach God with boldness and confidence?**
- How might fixing your mind on things above reshape your daily life?**

Shawn reminded us that miracles aren't about merit, but mindset. God works through broken people because there are no other kinds and Scripture is full of examples. Moses, David, Paul,

Peter and each were flawed but available. Grace makes us eligible, and a renewed mind keeps us engaged. It's not about earning a miracle, but choosing to believe God still moves.

- Why do you think God chooses to work through broken people?**
- What's one mindset shift you need to make in order to believe more fully in God's power?**

## MOVE

**Read Matthew 19:26 & James 5:16**

These passages push us toward active faith, faith that prays, fasts, and surrounds itself with others who believe. Miracles aren't solo acts; they're often born in community and strengthened through shared belief.

- Where do you need to lean on someone else's faith while you wait for your own breakthrough?**
- What would it look like to bring your impossible situation into your small group's prayers?**

Shawn called us to fast, pray, and believe as a church not to try and manipulate God, but to focus on Him. Fasting isn't just about subtraction, it's about replacement: turning hunger, distraction, or time into space for God. Whether you choose a soul fast or a food fast, the goal is alignment. Set your mind on Him, and trust Him to move.

- What kind of fast would help you tune into God's presence this week?**
- How can you create space each day to replace distraction with connection to God?**

## PRAY

This week, swap written prayer requests and commit to praying daily for someone else's miracle. Lean into the practice of intercession, it's not just comforting, it's powerful. Pray for the courage to believe God for the impossible, for His grace to replace striving with trust, and for specific needs in your group, healing, provision, clarity. Ask God to shift your mindset toward deeper spiritual focus in this 21-day season.
